Now President of Napa Valley Orthopaedics, Dr. Diana has served as Chairman of Surgery at Queen of the Valley Hospital, Chairman of the Surgical Quality Council at Queen of the Valley Hospital and will be serving as a Board Member for Queen of the Valley's charitable Foundation in the coming year.
